## **What is a Novena?**

The word novena is taken from “novem,” the Latin word for nine. A novena is made up of nine days of prayer and meditation usually to ask God for special prayer requests or petitions. Novenas are often used to ask specific saints to pray for us.

For nine days, we celebrate by praying - like the Apostles with the Blessed Mother from the Ascension of Our Lord to Heaven, leading up to Pentecost - to gain special favors from the Holy Spirit. For the purpose of our spiritual journey, we continue our pilgrimage to the heart of the Father with St. Therese - the Little Flower - our patroness.

Whether communal or in private, novena prayers are always marked by a sense of urgency and focus. This is not just daily prayer, but purposeful attention to intense, heartfelt, and repeated prayer of petition.

## **How do we pray the Novena to St. Therese?**

We have just consecrated ourselves to Jesus through Mary. Now, with active participation and celebration of the gifts that we hope to receive as a parish on October 1 - the Feast of St Therese, we pray together. For nine days, leading up to our feast day of our patroness, we journey and pray with a sincere heart the daily prayers in this booklet.

While on this prayerful journey, we need to be aware of the “little opportunities” to do God’s will: the little ways we can serve others, the little things we can do for each other to live out our Catholic faith. With openness to the love of God, we could hopefully notice and appreciate Jesus Christ, who is present, especially in the littlest things.

Jesus reminds us in the Gospel to be persistent in prayer and a novena is a great way to do that! Let us pray this Novena asking St Therese to help us be more like her in showing our love for Jesus and others in little ways in our everyday life.

## Day 1 - September 22

*(Make the Sign of the Cross)*

Dearest Saint Therese of Lisieux, you said that "Holiness consists simply in doing God's will, and being just what God wants us to be". Help me to trust God's plan for me. Pray to God that He may increase my faith in His goodness and mercy as I ask for the following petitions...

*The parish intention for today is  
for our those who are disconnected from our parish  
(You can also add your own personal intention)*

Pray for me that I, like you, may have great and innocent confidence in the loving promises of our God. Pray that I may live my life in union with God's plan for me, and one day see the Face of God whom you loved so deeply.

Saint Therese, you were faithful to God even unto the moment of your death. Pray for me that I may be faithful to our loving God. May my life bring peace and love to the world through faithful endurance in love for God our savior.

*Our Father...*

Loving God, you blessed St. Therese with a capacity for great love. Help me to believe in your unconditional love for each of your children, especially for me.

I love you, Lord. Help me to love you more!

## Day 2 - September 23

*(Make the Sign of the Cross)*

Dearest Saint Therese of Lisieux, you said that “true charity consists in bearing all our neighbor’s defects - not being surprised at their weakness, but edified at their smallest virtues”. Help me to learn to draw goodness from the smallest virtues of my brothers and sisters, and pray to God that He may increase my faith in His goodness and mercy as I ask for the following petitions...

*The parish intention for today is for our homebound and sick parishioners*

Pray for me that I, like you, may have great and innocent confidence in the loving promises of our God. Pray that I may live my life in union with God’s plan for me, and one day see the Face of God whom you loved so deeply.

Saint Therese, you were faithful to God even unto the moment of your death. Pray for me that I may be faithful to our loving God. May my life bring peace and love to the world through faithful endurance in love for God our savior.

*Our Father...*

Loving God, you loved St. Therese’s complete trust in your care. Help me to rely on your providential care in each circumstance of my life, especially the most difficult and stressful.

## Day 3 - September 24

*(Make the Sign of the Cross)*

*The parish intention for today is for our priests and deacon*

Pray for me that I, like you, may have great and innocent confidence in the loving promises of our God. Pray that I may live my life in union with God's plan for me, and one day see the Face of God whom you loved so deeply.

Saint Therese, you were faithful to God even unto the moment of your death. Pray for me that I may be faithful to our loving God. May my life bring peace and love to the world through faithful endurance in love for God our savior.

*Our Father...*

Loving God, you gave St. Therese the ability to see You in the ordinary routine of each day. Help me to be aware of your presence in the everyday events of my life.

Help me to appreciate the tiniest gifts that God places on my path everyday. Pray to God that He may increase my hope in His goodness and mercy as I ask for the following petitions...

*The parish intention for today is for our youth and young adults*  
(You can also add your own personal intention)

Pray for me that I, like you, may have great and innocent confidence in the loving promises of our God. Pray that I may live my life in union with God’s plan for me, and one day see the Face of God whom you loved so deeply.

Saint Therese, you were faithful to God even unto the moment of your death. Pray for me that I may be faithful to our loving God. May my life bring peace and love to the world through faithful endurance in love for God our savior.

*Our Father...*

Loving God, You taught St. Therese how to find You through the “little way” of humility and simplicity. Grant that I may never miss the grace hidden in humble service to others.

*The parish intention for today is  
for those who are suffering for whatever reason  
(You can also add your own personal intention)*

Pray for me that I, like you, may have great and innocent confidence in the loving promises of our God. Pray that I may live my life in union with God’s plan for me, and one day see the Face of God whom you loved so deeply.

Saint Therese, you were faithful to God even unto the moment of your death. Pray for me that I may be faithful to our loving God. May my life bring peace and love to the world through faithful endurance in love for God our savior.

*Our Father...*

Loving God, You gave St. Therese the gift of forgiving others even when she felt hurt and betrayed. Help me to be able to forgive others who have wounded me, especially...

Pray for me that I, like you, may have great and innocent confidence in the loving promises of our God. Pray that I may live my life in union with God's plan for me, and one day see the Face of God whom you loved so deeply.

Saint Therese, you were faithful to God even unto the moment of your death. Pray for me that I may be faithful to our loving God. May my life bring peace and love to the world through faithful endurance in love for God our savior.

*Our Father...*

Loving God, St. Therese never doubted that her life had meaning. Help me to see how I can bless and love everyone in my life. Especially...

I love your people, Lord. Help me to love them more!

I reflect you to the world, Lord. Help me to reflect you more clearly!

I rely on you, Lord. Help me to rely on you more!
